A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the transfer of a vehicle to an insurance company."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 28.10.285. Transfer to insurance company.** (a) When the owner of a
5 registered vehicle transfers or assigns the owner's title or interest to an insurance
6 company after payment of damages, the supporting documents used to transfer
7 ownership need not be notarized and may be signed electronically and printed. In this
8 subsection, "supporting document" includes a power of attorney, duplicate title, and
9 odometer disclosure forms.

10 (b) The insurance company shall indemnify and hold harmless the department
11 for any claims resulting from issuing a title under this section.
