



School Choice

 - 33 private schools serve 4,000 students (20% are non-faith-based).
 - 30 correspondence (homeschool) schools serve 23,000 students.
 - 503 public schools serving 131,587 students.

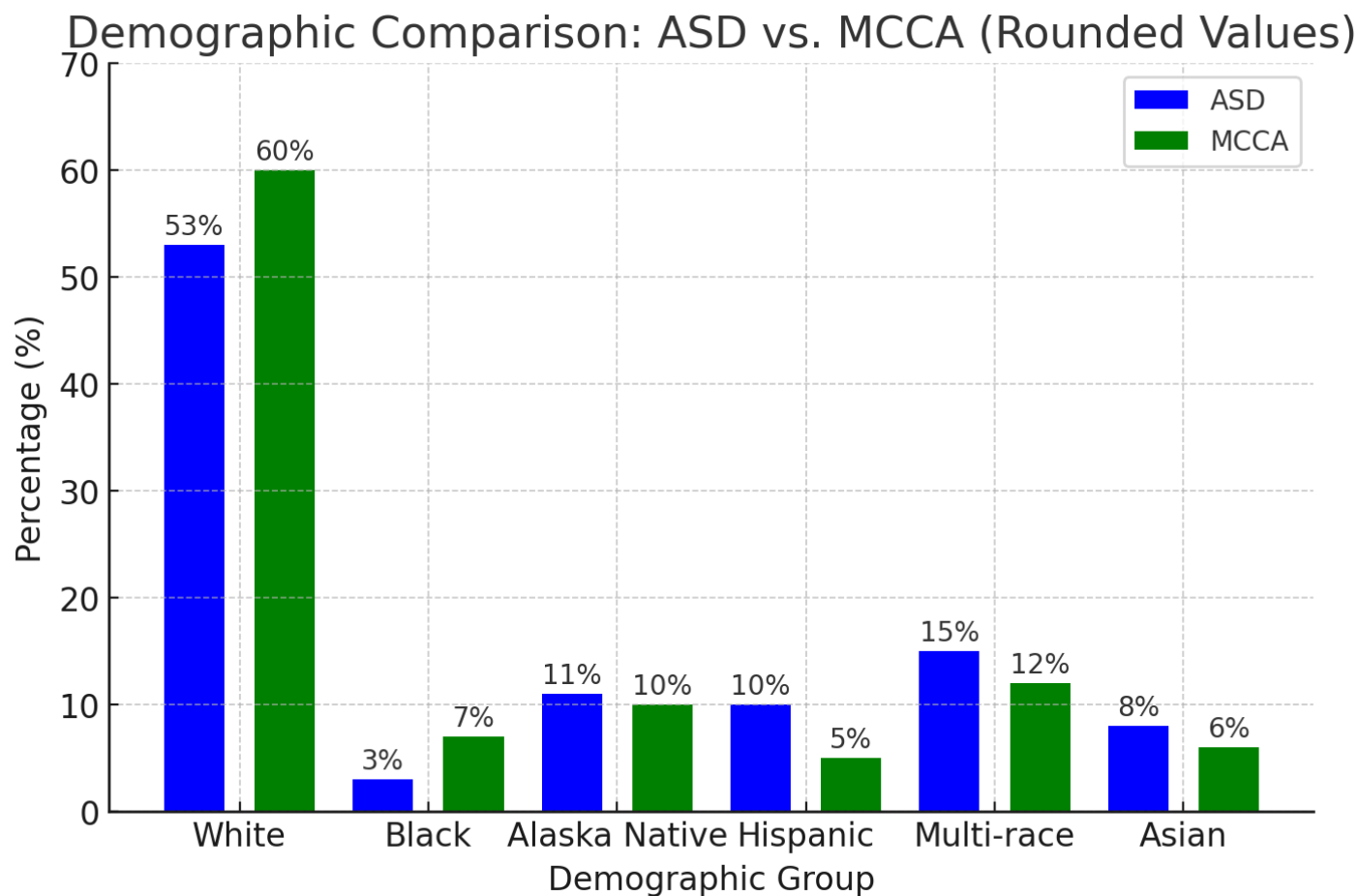
