

Enacted to Actuals Overview (FY2021 to current) (\$ in thousands)




FY2027 Gov: \$354,559.9 (2.0% increase from FY2026)



Detachments	\$1,303.0	UGF	Support annual lifecycle costs for body-worn and in-car camera systems previously funded in the Capital budget and with federal funding.
Alaska Bureau of Investigations	\$1,000.0	Other	Provide investigative support to Department of Law in domestic violence and sexual assault cases.
Alaska Bureau of Investigations	\$26.3	UGF	Added authority to for an IT position allocated to the ABI component which is included in the classification study conducted by DOA.



Criminal Justice Information Systems	\$27.0	UGF	Add authority to reflect job classification changes for Information Technology positions associated with the classification study conducted by DOA.



FY2026 Midyear Status Report

Continuity of Essential Services

- **Dispatch Contracts:** Services on the Kenai Peninsula Borough and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough are maintained through contract extensions and existing authority.
- **Trooper Schedule- Letter of Agreement:** The LOA gives the department the ability to maintain coverage of troopers by using alternate work schedules and management of overtime.
- **Two Northwest Region Child Crime Investigators:** The two child crimes investigator positions have been filled on the Northwest coast and have been instrumental at increasing the investigative efforts in the region. To date, the investigators have 23 open cases.



FY2026 Midyear Status Report

Current Year Operating Considerations

- **\$1,000.0 Trooper Overtime:** Trooper overtime trending high but is within authorized funding.
- **Aircraft operations:** Trending above budget due to maintenance and fuel volatility.
- **Law Enforcement Equipment:** Supply cost increases are being managed through deferred purchases and reduced non-essential travel.
- **Maintaining the Budget within Available Authority:** Use of vacant position funding and non-essential travel budgets to offset rising operational costs.



FY2026 Midyear Status Report

Structural Long-Term Cost Pressures

- **Aircraft operations:** Operational costs are trending above budget due to maintenance and fuel increases.
- **Law enforcement supplies:** Costs continue to increase, risking further procurement delays.
- **Village Public Safety Officer programs:** Rural cost realities, and over 120 rural communities continue to see limited or non-existent coverage.
- **Capital Project Oversight:** Managed by existing staff, “Other Duties as Assigned”
