FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

The bill creates a new type of protective order for guardianship and conservatorship by adding a new article to Alaska Statute (AS) 13.29. Under the new section, a court may issue an order for a protective arrangement instead of guardianship or conservatorship.

The bill amends AS 18.65.540 requiring the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to maintain these protective orders in the central registry of protective orders, and peace officers to enter the orders, modified orders, or dismissed orders into the registry within 24 hours after being received.

The DPS Division of Statewide Services (SWS) is responsible for maintaining the State's central registry of protective orders under AS 18.65.540. The Alaska Public Safety Information Network that houses the central registry will need to be modified programmatically to accept and maintain the workplace violence protective orders.

DPS is transitioning the Alaska Public Safety Information Network off the legacy mainframe effective January 2026 as part of a comprehensive criminal justice information services modernization project. The one-time cost quoted by the new vendor to add workplace violence protective orders to the central registry is \$150.0.
