CSHB101(FIN) Summary of Changes Version I (34-LS0451\I) 5/20/2025

HB 101A was introduced on February 12, 2025. On March 10, 2025, the Judiciary Committee offered a Committee Substitute reflecting the following changes:

Section 4: *AS 11.41.220(a) - Assault in the third degree*

Section 4 is amended to maintain a 2-year close in age exemption for the crime of assault in the third degree.

Section 10: *AS 11.41.452(a) - Enticement of a minor*

Section 10 is amended to maintain a 2-year close in age exemption for the crime of enticement of a minor and updates language for readability.

Section 19: *AS 11.61.128(a) - Distribution of indecent material to minors*

Section 19 is amended to maintain a 2-year close in age exemption for the crime of distribution of indecent material to minors and updates language for readability.

On April 28, 2025, the House Finance Committee offered a Committee Substitute with the following changes:

Section 7: *AS 11.41.434(a) - Sexual abuse of a minor in the first degree*

Section 7 is amended to maintain a 2-year close in age exemption for the crime of sexual abuse of a minor in the first degree relating to persons with authority

Section 8: *AS 11.41.436(a) - Sexual abuse of a minor in the second degree*

Section 8 Subsection (a) 1 is amended to create a 6-year close in age exemption relating to 16- and 17-year-olds for the crime of sexual abuse of a minor in the second degree.

Subsection (a) 5 is amended to maintain a 2-year close in age exemption for the crime of sexual abuse of a minor in the second degree relating to persons with authority.

Section 9: *AS 11.41.438(a) - Sexual abuse of a minor in the third degree*

Section 9 is amended to create a 6-year close in age exemption relating to 16- and 17-year-olds for the crime of sexual abuse of a minor in the third degree.
