FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
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Analysis

HB392 expands the authority of an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse to the same authority as a physician within the effected statues as they relate to the pronouncement of death, certification of death, determining death in a healthcare facility, and the issuance of Do Not Resuscitate orders.

Regulation 7 AAC 16.10 will need to be amended. There are a few areas where Physician Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment (POLST), including the acronym POLST itself, will need to be updated. The regulations can be changed to Medical Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment (MOLST).

The bill will have a minimal financial impact; therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
