HB130: Flexible Time Credit for Classified Employees

Sectional Analysis Version N

- Sec. 1** Adds a new section establishing that classified employees who are not eligible for overtime compensation shall accrue flexible time credit for each hour or fraction of an hour worked in excess of the employee's standard work week.

Flexible time credit has no cash value and is lost if the employee separates from service.

These new requirements do not apply for employees who have nonstandard work schedules requiring staying at the workplace for 24+ hour periods, for example firefighters and marine highway employees.

- Sec. 2** Amends the scope of personnel rules, to provide for new methods and procedures covering flexible time credit as described in Sec. 1.

- Sec. 3** Clarifies that the changes in this Act apply to collective bargaining contracts entered into after the effective date.
