### Sectional Analysis

#### Senate Bill 140

Section 1: Adds a new Article 6A to AS 29.60 creating the Fire Station Grant Program.

**Sec. 29.60.750** Creates the Fire Station Grant Program as a matching grant program within the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development. Allows grants for up to 50 percent of eligible projects to construct or renovate fire stations.

**Sec. 29.60.760** Establishes the Fire Station Grant Fund as a separate fund in the department and provides a framework for use of the fund.

**Sec. 29.60.770** Instructs the department to adopt regulations necessary to implement the fire station grant program.

Section 2: Establishes an effective date of July 1, 2025.
