FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB210

Analysis

This bill amends AS 14.03.015 *State Education Policy*, to add policy intent language relating to learning about the distinct and unique cultural heritages of Alaska Natives and American Indians in a culturally responsive manner. This policy directs local education agencies to work with tribes to include cultural heritage and contemporary contributions of Alaska Natives and American Indians, with emphasis on tribal groups and governments in the state and to consult and contract with local tribal entities to provide training and appreciation for Alaska Native and American Indian people.

There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Education and Early Development as a result of this legislation.
