Hi Hayden, here are responses to your two questions.

Regarding tribal IDs- From a policy perspective, there would need to be a statutory or regulatory requirement to enable tribal IDs to be used for iSSNRC. Currently, the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) only conducts verifications with State Departments of Motor Vehicles (DMVs). For tribal IDs to be included, tribal communities would need to register with their respective State DMVs. It is important to note that tribal communities may have reservations or may not wish to register with their State DMVs, which could present additional challenges. At this time, AAMVA's verification process is limited to state-issued credentials.

AAMVA collects the following data elements:

- First Name
- Last Name
- Date of Birth (DOB)
- State DL or ID number
- State of issuance
- Address (street, city, state, zip code)

This bill pertains only to the data from a driver's license to a verification program then to the SSA correct? To allow tribal ID verification it would have to be a federal change? My second question is that the data being used by the AASMVA is just the persons date of birth, name address and SSN, is there any other data being gathered?
