SB 211-EXTEND OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING BOARDS

"An Act extending the termination date of the Board of Professional Counselors; extending the termination date of the Board of Marital and Family Therapy; extending the termination date of the Board of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners; extending the termination date of the Real Estate Commission; extending the termination date of the Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers; extending the termination date of the Board of Social Work Examiners; relating to reports on the Board of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners and the Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers; and providing for an effective date."

Summary of Changes ver. A to ver. G

Page 1, lines 4-5: Bill title is amended by adding the extension of the Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers and additional reports required of the Boards of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners Certified Real Estate Appraisers.

Page 2, lines 9-11, New Section 5: Amends AS 08.03.010(c)(20) extending the Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers from 2026 to 2032.

Page 2, lines 12-14, Section 6: Renumbered from Version A, Section 5.

Page 2, lines 15-23, New Section 7: Adds new section of uncodified law directing the Legislative Audit Division to submit reports by the first day of the Thirty-sixth Alaska State Legislature to the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee concerning compliance by the Boards of Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners and of Certified Real Estate Appraisers with the State's 2025 audits' recommendations.
