Recreating the Cook Inlet Salmon Task Force as a joint legislative task force.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Twenty-Fifth Alaska State Legislature adopted Legislative Resolve 51 establishing the Cook Inlet Salmon Task Force; and

WHEREAS Legislative Resolve 51 requires the task force to submit a report with recommendations and findings to the legislature by January 20, 2009, and terminates the task force on February 1, 2009; and

WHEREAS the task force has been meeting and taking testimony and preparing its recommendations and findings but has not completed its work or submitted its recommendations and findings as required by Legislative Resolve 51; and

WHEREAS the task force will not be able to complete its work or submit its recommendations and findings before the task force is terminated as provided by Legislative Resolve 51; and

WHEREAS the task force has requested that it be permitted to submit its recommendations and findings by March 31, 2010, and that the task force be terminated on April 20, 2010;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Cook Inlet Salmon Task Force is recreated on February 1, 2009, and shall submit its recommendations and findings to the legislature not later than March 31, 2010; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cook Inlet Salmon Task Force is composed of 10 legislators: five members from the senate appointed by the president of the senate and five members from the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is terminated April 20, 2010.
