#### A BILL

#### FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to use of child safety seats and seat belts."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. AS 28.05.095(b) is amended to read:
  - (b) Except as provided in (c) of this section, a driver may not transport a child under the age of 16 in a motor vehicle unless the driver has provided the required safety device and properly secured each child as described in this subsection. A [IF THE] child
  - (1) to at least one year of age shall be properly secured in a rear-facing child safety seat that meets or exceeds [IS LESS THAN FOUR YEARS OF AGE, THE CHILD SHALL BE PROPERLY SECURED IN A CHILD SAFETY DEVICE MEETING] the standards of the United States Department of Transportation;
  - (2) who weighs less than at least 20 pounds shall be properly secured in a rear-facing child safety seat that meets or exceeds the standards of the United States Department of Transportation;

(3) who weighs at least 20 pounds but less than 40 pounds shall be secured in a forward-facing or rear-facing child safety seat, whichever is more appropriate for the child and is in accord with the manufacturer's instructions, that meets or exceeds the standards of the United States Department of Transportation;

- (4) who weighs 40 pounds or more but is less than 57 inches in height shall be secured in a booster seat that is secured by a safety belt system or by another child passenger restraint system that meets or exceeds the standards of the United States Department of Transportation;
- (5) who exceeds the height requirements of (4) of this subsection shall be properly secured in a safety belt;
- (6) who does not exceed the height requirements in (4) of this subsection but is at least eight years of age [FOR A CHILD SAFETY DEVICE FOR INFANTS. IF THE CHILD IS FOUR] but not yet 16 years of age [, THE CHILD] shall be properly secured in a child safety device approved for a child of that age and size by the United States Department of Transportation or in a safety belt, whichever is appropriate for the particular child.
- \* Sec. 2. AS 28.05.095 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
  - (g) Child safety seats, booster seats, and restraint systems required under (b) of this section must be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
