- (d) A permit issued under (a) of this section expires on the person's birthday
- in the fifth year following issuance of the license. The department may adjust the 5 6
- length of an initial permit so that a permit is not issued for a period of more than 7
- five years [IS VALID FOR FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE].
- * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to 8 9 read:
- 10 APPLICABILITY. AS 18.65.700(d), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to permits issued and renewed after the effective date of this Act. 11
