#### FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

#### 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. AS 44.42.300 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 4
- (d) An action may not be brought against the state or employees of the state 6 for a claim arising out of design, operations, maintenance, or construction activities 7 performed by, or under the management of, federally recognized tribes in Alaska
- 8 acting in furtherance of the Indian Reservation Roads Program under 25 C.F.R. 170 or
- 9 other federal transportation programs or transportation grants designed to benefit
- 10 tribes.
- \* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to 11
- 12 read:
- 13 APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to claims arising on or after the effective date of
- 14 this Act.

- 3 REVISOR'S INSTRUCTION. The revisor of statutes shall change the catch line of
- 4 AS 44.42.300 from "Authorization to participate in certain federal highway programs" to
- 5 "Participation in certain federal highway programs."
