## Sectional Analysis of House Bill 151:

<u>Section 1</u> of the bill repeals temporary law sections and amendments to sections of temporary law from ch. 28, SLA 2000. Chapter 28, SLA 2000, created the state boating safety and education program, including boating safety equipment requirements, boating operating restrictions, accident reporting requirements, and provisions related to civil liability for boating accidents. The sections repealed in sec. 1 of the bill provide that the state boating and safety education program will not be amended to remove the program.

<u>Section 2</u> of the bill provides for an effective date by repealing the effective dates of the temporary law sections listed in sec. 1 of the bill.

<u>Section 3</u> of the bill provides for an immediate effective date.
