

DEFINITIONS (in quotations) AND OTHER ISSUES:

- P.1 LINE 8 – Should we consider using a different term than affordable – or do we define it?
- P.2 LINE 15 – A typo – “use” will be changed to “new”
- P.3 LINE 22 – Should transportation be included – or are we talking transporting energy?
- P. 3 LINE 24 – “Rational Development” - consider changing the term or define it.
- P. 3 LINES 3 & 28 – “prudent” - consider changing the term or define it.
- P.4 LINE 1-2 – “Clean Energy Production” and “Clean Sources” – should we consider changing this to renewable or do we want to define what “clean” is? Should we list the renewable or clean sources or should we do it a different way?

SUGGESTED DEFINITIONS

“flat-priced” – A price per unit which remains constant

“off-peak” – Electrical Energy supplied during a period of relatively low system demand as specified in a contract.

“rate shock” – An unexpected fluctuation in costs per unit of energy
