Substance Abuse

GOAL Decrease the negative impacts of alcohol and drug use in Alaska.

OUTCOMES

- 1. Reduce incidence of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD).
- 2. Reduce substance abuse related accidents.
- 3. Reduce substance abuse related violence and crime.
- 4. Reduce substance abuse related suicides.

Health & Wellness

GOAL Improve the health status of Alaskans.

OUTCOMES

- 1. Reduce tobacco use in Alaska.
- 2. Reduce the rate of obesity in Alaska.
- 3. Improve the oral health of Alaskans.
- 4. Reduce unintended injuries in Alaska.
- 5. Expand preventative health interventions.

Health Care Reform

GOAL Improve access to quality health care in Alaska.

OUTCOMES

- 1. Expand Alaska's health care workforce.
- 2. Improve coordination and integration of behavioral health and primary care services.
- 3. Expand health care financing options.

Long Term Care

GOAL Increase the percentage of adults 65 and older living independently in Alaska.

OUTCOMES

- 1. Increase public awareness of long term care services.
- 2. Increase access to long term care services.
- 3. Expand "in home" support services and programs.

Vulnerable Populations

GOAL Increase the percentage of at-risk individuals who are able to live safely in their home in Alaska.

OUTCOMES

- 1. Reduce the percentage of children and adults removed from their homes as a result of abuse or neglect.
- 2. Reduce the percentage of youth who are incarcerated in juvenile detention facilities.
- 3. Reduce the number of youth with Severe Emotional Disturbance (SED) in in-state and out-of-state Residential Psychiatric Treatment Centers (RPTC).
- 4. Increase the number of individuals and families reaching self-sufficiency through employment.
- 5. Improve the provision of safety-net program services.
