HB 355 raises the potential fine for conviction of a crime by an organization. It does so by providing that the fine may be three times the pecuniary gain that was sought by the defendant or others by the crime, or three times the potential loss that the defendant sought by the commission of the offense. There is no anticipated fiscal impact to Department of Law.
