FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act requiring the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to publish on the department's Internet website reports regarding the status of active transportation projects."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. AS 44.42.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
 - (f) When an appropriation has been made to the department for a transportation project included in the list of projects required under (d) of this section, the commissioner shall
 - (1) prepare and publish information about the project on the department's Internet website; the information must include
 - (A) the name of the project;
 - (B) a description of the project;
 - (C) the status of the project;
 - (D) all amounts appropriated for the project with dates of the

appropriations and fund sources;

- (E) all expenditures from project inception until the date the information is published;
 - (F) future funding needed to complete the project;
 - (G) the phase or stage of work the project has reached;
- (H) the name of the prime contractor performing the construction if construction has begun;
- (I) the project schedule from inception to completion and any changes in the schedule that have occurred; and
- (J) geographic location of the project, including the borough or census district and the election district; and
 - (2) update the information for each project semi-annually.
- * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

APPLICABILITY. AS 44.42.050(f), added by sec. 1 of this Act, applies only to projects for which an appropriation is made on or after the effective date of this Act.
