* Sec. 3. FINDINGS. The legislature finds that the State of Alaska has realized savings in
the amount of \$106,261,000 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, through the federa
medical assistance percentage provisions of P.L. 111-5 (American Recovery and
Reinvestment Act of 2009) that are being used to finance appropriations made from the
general fund in this Act.

- * Sec. 4. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. The sum of \$250,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.316 to World Trade Center Alaska for the 2010 world expo for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011.
- * Sec. 5. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS. The sum of \$10,462,600 is appropriated to the Department of Corrections to implement the interest arbitration decision dated March 19, 2009, establishing monetary terms of the collective bargaining agreement with the Alaska Correctional Officers Association, for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011, from the following sources:

- * Sec. 6. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES. The sum of \$242.72 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health and Social Services, division of juvenile justice, for payment of unpaid bills for services received in 2003 and 2004, for fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
- * Sec. 7. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT. Section 9(d), ch. 14, SLA 2009, is amended to read:

- * Sec. 11. FUND CAPITALIZATION. The sum of \$5,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the disaster relief fund (AS 26.23.300(a)).
- * Sec. 12. FUND TRANSFERS. (a) The sum of \$1,116,986,600 is appropriated from the general fund to the public education fund (AS 14.17.300).
- (b) The sum of \$79,000 is appropriated from the Alaska Industrial Development and Export Authority revolving fund (AS 44.88.060) to the small business economic development revolving loan fund (AS 44.88.400).
- (c) The unexpended and unobligated balance of the appropriation made in sec. 18(b), ch. 30, SLA 2007 (Department of Natural Resources, assistance to the Creamery Corporation, dba Matanuska Maid Dairy - \$600,000) is reappropriated to the agricultural revolving loan fund (AS 03.10.040).
- * Sec. 13. RATIFICATIONS OF CERTAIN EXPENDITURES. (a) The expenditures by the Department of Natural Resources for fire suppression for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (AR 37313-09 Fire General Fund), are ratified in the amount of \$10,297,678.22.

- * Sec. 17. REVENUE AND APPROPRIATION BALANCE; CONSTITUTIONAL BUDGET RESERVE. (a) The amount necessary for full repayment of the amounts owed the budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec. 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska), as of June 30, 2010, estimated to be \$401,617,000, is appropriated from the general fund to the budget reserve fund (art.
