This bill provides that a person who is restricted from purchasing alcohol may not solicit another to purchase alcoholic beverages or misrepresent the restriction to a licensee. The bill also provides that the court, as part of a sentence, may order the defendant to refrain from consuming alcohol for the period of the sentence and any period of probation, suspended sentence, or suspended imposition of sentence if the conviction was for a felony substantially influenced by alcohol consumption or the defendant had a history of drunk driving offenses.

Enactment of the bill is not anticipated to fiscally impact the Department of Law.
