HB 95 would change the postjudgment interest rate in some instances for judgments and administrative determinations >\$100,000 in favor of the state or a political subdivision of the state. It would also require that a judgment debtor requesting a stay of execution of such a judgment post security to cover the the full amount of the judgment including postjudgment interest. It is anticipated this legislation will have no fiscal impact on the Department.
