1 "An Act relating to the purchase of alcoholic beverages at a club and to access by
2 certain persons under 21 years of age to a club's licensed premises when alcoholic
3 beverages are present."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 04.11.110(d) is amended to read:

6 (d) Alcoholic beverages sold under a club license may be purchased only by
7 (1) members of the club and their families, (2) widows or widowers of deceased
8 members who have been accorded club privileges, and (3) military personnel on active
9 duty, and their accompanying spouses, who are extended the privilege by patriotic
10 organizations, if the person on active duty possesses a valid active duty military or
11 armed services identification card issued by the United States Department of
12 Defense or United States Department of Homeland Security [UPON SPECIAL
13 OCCASIONS]. Alcoholic beverages may be purchased only in the portion of the club
14 rooms that are part of the licensed premises.

1 * **Sec. 2.** AS 04.11.110(g) is amended to read:

2 (g) **Access** [NOTWITHSTANDING AS 04.16.049, ACCESS] by persons
3 under 21 years of age to

4 (1) a club's licensed premises is permitted when alcoholic beverages
5 are not present; and

6 (2) the premises of a patriotic organization licensed as a club under this
7 section is permitted when alcoholic beverages are present, if the person **is a guest of a**
8 **member of the club, or the spouse accompanying a guest, and the guest** possesses
9 a valid active duty military or armed forces identification card issued by the United
10 States Department of Defense or the United States Department of Homeland Security.

11 * **Sec. 3.** AS 04.16.049(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) A person under the age of 21 years may not knowingly enter or remain in
13 premises licensed under this title unless

14 (1) accompanied by a parent, guardian, or spouse who has attained the
15 age of 21 years;

16 (2) the person is at least 16 years of age, the premises are designated
17 by the board as a restaurant for the purposes of this section, and the person enters and
18 remains only for dining; [OR]

19 (3) the person is under the age of 16 years, is accompanied by a person
20 over the age of 21 years, the parent or guardian of the underaged person consents, the
21 premises are designated by the board as a restaurant for the purposes of this section,
22 and the person enters and remains only for dining; **or**

23 **(4) the person is permitted on the premises under AS 04.11.110(g).**
