## Analysis

House Bill 367 adds a new factor to the list of mitigating factors in AS 12.55.155(d) that the court shall consider at sentencing if proven. If proven, the court may then impose a sentence below the presumptive range for certain crimes. Specifically, except for defendants convicted of offenses against persons and first degree arson, a defendant may show that he or she committed the offense while suffering from a diagnosed fetal alcohol spectrum disorder, that the disorder substantially impaired the defendant's judgment (or behavior, capacity to recognize reality, or ability to cope with the ordinary demands of life), and that the disorder significantly affected his or her conduct.						
The court cannot predict the number of cases in which defendants will attempt to prove this factor as a mitigator at sentencing, but believes the sentencing hearings will be held and handled in the normal course without a fiscal impact. The Alaska Court System therefore submits a zero fiscal note.
