RE: Examples of 501(c)3 Nonprofits that have Received SCHDF Grants

Thank you again for hearing HB 65—Senior Citizens Housing Development Fund Grants—on February 1st in the Community & Regional Affairs Committee.

At the hearing, Rep. Saddler asked for examples of already-qualifying nonprofit organizations that have been recipients of SCHDF grants. I have looked into the question, and I write now to provide the requested examples.

They include the Retirement Community of Fairbanks as well as the Mid-Valley Senior Citizens—two of the three entities whose projects were described in an item in the committee members' bill packets titled "Examples of Senior Housing Projects Partly Funded with Senior Citizens Housing Development Grants."
