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SB 83 establishes payment and loan incentives intended to assist Alaska public school teachers seeking to earn national board certification. One component is the establishment and funding of a zero interest loan to otherwise eligible teachers who are actively pursuing national certification of professional teaching standards awarded by a nationally recognized board. The loan amount is set at \$2,500 and the funds are to be paid directly to the national board from which the certification is being sought.
The Commission estimates to the expected limited demand for the loan that servicing the loan can be accomplished with existing staff resources. Assuming the loans will be funded by an appropriation to the Department of Education and Early Development, no funding is requested for that purpose.

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
