FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to prohibiting the use of cellular telephones when driving a motor
- 2 vehicle; and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 28.35.165. Prohibited use of cellular telephone. (a) A person may not use a cellular telephone when driving a motor vehicle on a highway or vehicular way
- 7 or area.
- 8 (b) This section does not apply to a person using a cellular telephone for 9 emergency purposes, including an emergency call to a law enforcement agency, fire
- department, or other emergency services agency or entity.
- 11 (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction and may be 12 punished as provided under AS 28.90.010.
- * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
