Analysis

This legislation requires that annual reports of all state agencies may only be made available electronically. An agency may not produce printed copies of annual reports unless specifically requested by an individual or if conflicts exist with provisions of law.

The cost for this note is indeterminate. The estimated cost for printing state agency annual reports is \$133.5. This includes over 28,000 copies from agencies that currently print and distribute annual reports. Several Departments currently distribute annual reports only electronically and do not realize printing costs. These include the Department of Law, the Alaska Judicial Council, the Department of Corrections and the Alaska Court System. Most Departments post annual reports as PDF documents on their websites. Other agencies, such as the Alaska Commission on Judicial Conduct, send notifications informing people that their reports can be downloaded from their website and that a report will only be sent to them if requested.

This fiscal note is indeterminate because the cost for producing annual reports is not linear. The fewer reports that are produced, the greater the cost per report. The cost is attributed to the required setup by the printer, not so much the actual printing. If the number of copies is reduced from 1,000 to 100, there will most likely be a reduction in the overall cost, but the amount saved is inconclusive since the cost per copy will be greater.
