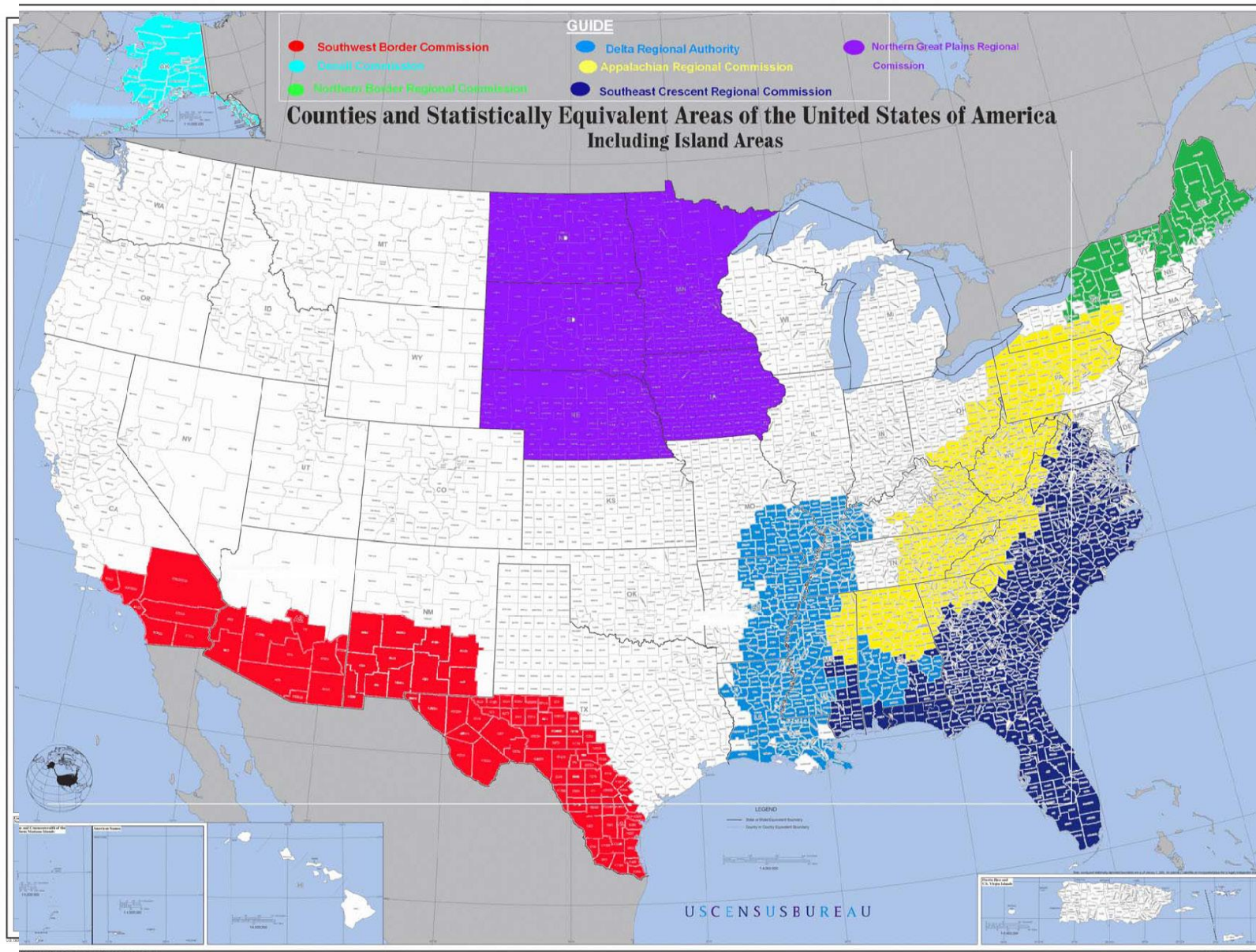

Denali Commission Act**

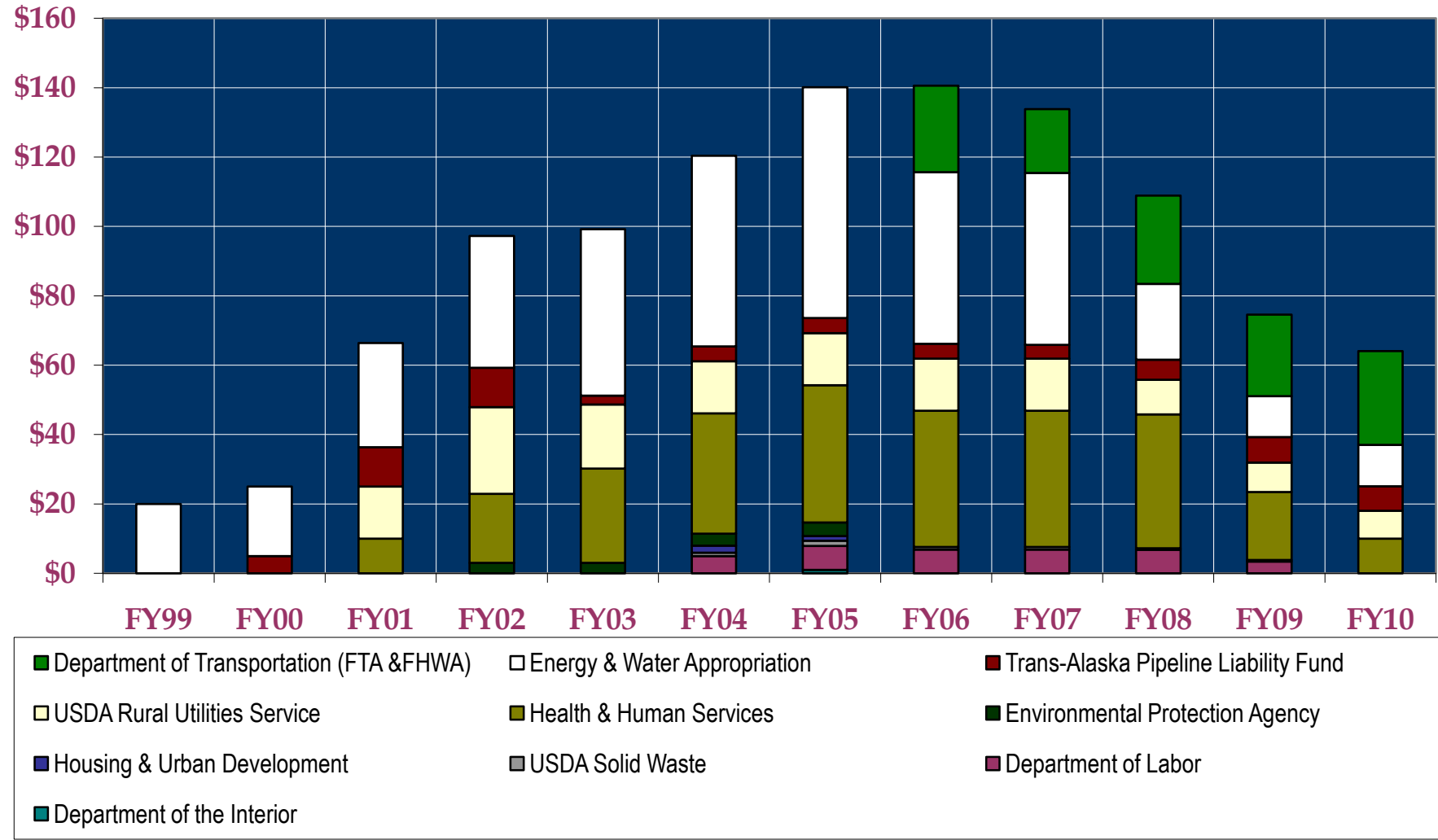
Governing Principles:

(in millions)



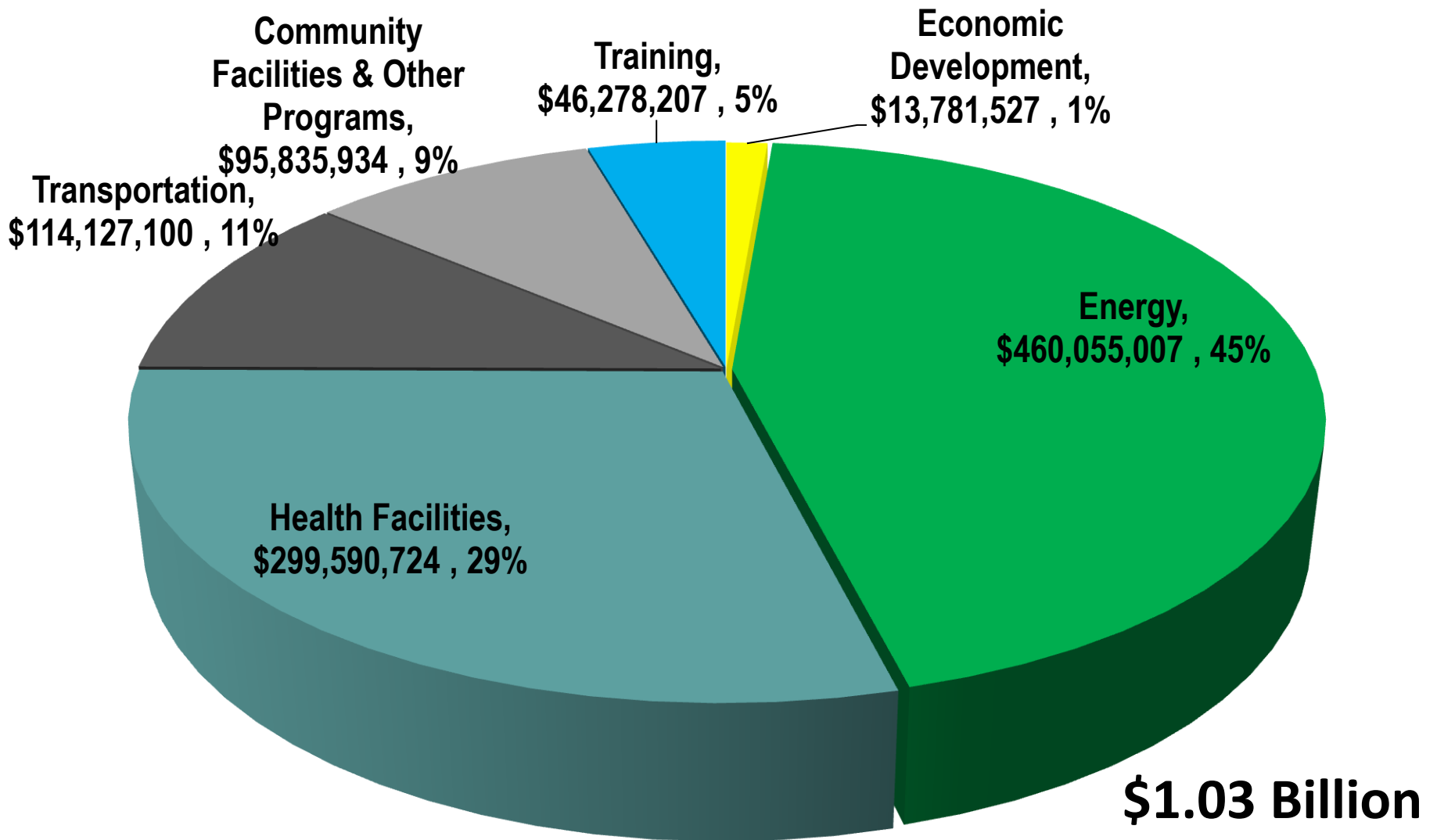

- Program Funded in FY2005
- SAFETEA LU – Legislation provided ~ \$100 million to Denali Commission FY2005-2009
- Annually Provides ~\$25,000,000 to the Commission
 - FHWA ~ \$15,000,000
 - FTA ~ \$10,000,000
