Allalysis
The Alaska Working Group on Interstate Energy Production shall consist of four (4) members, with two (2) senators appointed by the President of the Senate and two (2) representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Members of the Alaska Working Group on Interstate Energy Production may meet during and between regular sessions of the Alaska State Legislature and they may travel within Alaska and to other states as necessary to accomplish their purpose. The anticipated travel costs shown above provide each member of the working group with an annual travel budget of approximately \$5.0. However, this fiscal note does not ask for an increment to fund this travel. These travel costs will be absorbed in the Legislature's "Legislative Council " RDU in the "Session Expenses" Component. The Alaska Working Group on Interstate Energy Productions will terminate January 18, 2013.
