Analysis

The Alaska Working Group on Interstate Energy Production shall consist of four (4) members, with two (2) senators appointed by the President of the Senate and two (2) representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Members of the Alaska Working Group on Interstate Energy Production may meet during and between regular sessions of the Alaska State Legislature and they may travel within Alaska and to other states as necessary to accomplish their purpose.
