FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act prohibiting the use of a cellular telephone when driving a motor vehicle; and
- 2 providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 28.35.165. Prohibited use of cellular telephone. (a) A person may not use a cellular telephone when driving a motor vehicle on a highway or vehicular way or area.
- 8 (b) This section does not apply to a person using a cellular telephone
- 9 (1) for emergency purposes, including an emergency call to a law 10 enforcement agency, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity; or
- 11 (2) that has a voice-activated or hands-free mode or configuration if 12 the telephone is used in a voice-activated or hands-free manner.
- 13 (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction and may be 14 punished as provided under AS 28.90.010.

1 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
