FISCAL NOTE

STATE OF ALASKA 2012 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

SB 137's suicide awareness and prevention training meets EED's criteria for eLearning consideration. An eLearning course, as a distance-delivered medium, appears aligned with SB137's language. The training may be offered through video conferenceing or an individual program study of designated materials.
EED pays approximately \$20,000 per course hour (\$40,000 per two-hour course) of custom content to a vendor who builds the courses. In addition, the cost of convening a qualified committee together to review, refine and finalize course content and the additional costs to contract with suicide experts to build the two hours of course content (\$15,000) and EED staff time (\$5,000).
Ongoing cost includes the cost per learner EED incurs for each district personnel who registers for the course. EED pays an annual fee of \$6.25 for each eLearner (this fee allows the learner to take all of EED's eLearning courses). EED would also need to periodically review and update the course at a cost of \$5,000 -\$10,000 every few years.
