This bill proposes to allow an absentee by-mail ballot application from a qualified voter be valid for the next two regularly scheduled general elections. If a voter casts an absentee by-mail ballot the application would remain valid through the next two regularly scheduled general elections.  Currently state law allows an absentee by-mail application for absent uniformed services or absent overseas voters to be valid for the next two regularly scheduled general elections. Voting an absentee ballot does not currently extend their by-mail application.
