
REGIONAL JAILS and PRISONS

 Jails
➢ Incarcerated offenders from initial intake through sentencing.
➢ Incarcerated sentenced misdemeanants with 1 year or less remaining.
➢ Incarcerated sentenced felons with 1 year or less to serve.

Prisons

Incarcerated sentenced offenders (primarily felons) with more than 1 year to serve at time of sentencing.







Northwest Region Anvil Mountain CC (Nome) CRC

Community Jail-- Kotzebue












CORRECTIONS POPULATION BREAKDOWN 12/31/2011




Percent of Offenders by Length of Stay from Admission

As of December 31, 2011






Standing Population & Crime Type


