BILL NO. HB 144

Analysis

HB 144 would require the Department of Natural Resources, in consultation with the Department of Fish & Game, to provide an annual report to the legislature detailing the department's efforts during the previous year, and objectives in the upcoming year, to maintain and enhance access to and along fishing streams.

The only additional work would be to compile this information into the annual report. Costs associated with preparing the report and including it in the Division of Mining, Land & Water's annual report to the legislature could be addressed with existing staff and resources.
