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FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2013 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

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This bill would make it a class B misdemeanor for a federal official to enforce a federal law which attempts to ban or restrict ownership of a semiautomatic firearm or magazine or require that a firearm or firearm accessory be registered. A person convicted of a class B misdemeanor may be sentenced to a term of not more than 90 days in prison.		
This legislation is not expected to cause a dramatic increase in convictions which would require incarceration and, therefore, there is no fiscal impact to the Department.		

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
