FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the term of office of directors of telephone or electric cooperatives."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 10.25.160 is amended to read:

Sec. 10.25.160. Staggered terms of office for directors. Instead of electing
all directors annually, the bylaws may provide that directors shall be elected for terms
not to exceed <u>four</u> [THREE] years, or until their successors are elected and qualify,
and that the terms of directors shall be staggered so that <u>not all terms expire at the</u>
<u>same time</u> [ONE-THIRD OF THE DIRECTORS, OR A NUMBER AS CLOSE TO
ONE-THIRD AS POSSIBLE, SHALL BE ELECTED EACH YEAR].
