A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to issuance of drivers' licenses."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 28.15.101 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (d) Under regulations adopted by the department, the department may issue to 5 a person a driver's license with a duration of less than five years if the person is 6 authorized to stay in the United States for less than five years or the period of 7 authorized stay is indefinite. The department shall issue the license for the period of 8 the authorized stay. If the period of authorized stay is indefinite, the department shall 9 issue the license with a validity of one year. The department may provide that a person 10 receiving a license with a duration of less than five years under this subsection may 11 renew the license by mail and without a renewal fee during a period of up to five years 12 after first issuance of the license.
