

AP3 Program Quality Improvement by Approach

The Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale-Revised Edition (ECERS-R) is a 43 item scale designed for use in classroom-based early childhood care and education programs serving children aged two to six years. It is organized into seven scales: Space and Furnishing, Personal Care Routines, Language-Reasoning, Activities, Interaction, Program Structure, and Parents and Staff. Each scale area and the overall score (listed below across the 4 year program) are expressed on a scale of 1-7 with 7 as the highest level of quality.
