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Rural Alaska Water and Sewer Facilities: “Unserved” Communities

- A rural Alaska community is considered “unserved” if less than 55% of the year round occupied homes in the community are served by a piped or closed-haul system.
- Of Alaska’s 216 rural communities, 35 meet the definition of “unserved”. These are as follows:
