


FY2015 Budget By Division & Fund Source (\$216,071.2)

FY2015 Budget By Division



Highlights in Operating Budget for FY2015

- \$1 million increase in federal receipt authority for Wildlife Conservation, Pittman-Robertson funds
- Elimination of 36 vacant positions and associated funding
 - 10 permanent full-time
 - 12 permanent part-time/seasonal
 - 14 non-permanent
 - \$570.0 UGF reduction, \$739.0 federal reduction, \$509.8 other
- House Subcommittee Reduction of \$1 million UGF
