BILL NO. SB 190

Analysis

This bill would allow a registered guide-outfitter to delegate certain guide services to a person who is not licensed by the Big Game Commercial Services Board. It would also allow an unlicensed person to receive compensation for carrying out those duties.

Passage of this bill would have no fiscal impact to the Department of Public Safety, Division of Alaska Wildlife Troopers.
