BILL NO. SB156

Analysis

SB156 removes the licensure exemption for those observing cultural “lay midwife” traditions, increases the ability of the Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives to set standards for their profession in regulations, increases the qualifications of a midwifery supervisor, moves the conditions which restrict the midwife’s attendance of a birth out of statute and into regulation, and amends the definition of “practice of midwifery”.

The board must adopt regulations establishing practice requirements for certified direct-entry midwives under AS 08.65.140. The Board of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives meets two to four times a year and a board initiated regulation project requires additional time; the division believes an appropriate completion date for regulations revision is December 31, 2015.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
