BILL NO. SB 116

Analysis

Under current statute park rangers, who are peace officers, must personally serve every citation they issue, even for minor infractions such as non-payment of park fees or parking in a no-parking zone.

SB 116 adds a new subsection (d) to AS 12.25.175 allowing park rangers to cite individuals for violations of state park regulations by leaving a completed citation form on a vehicle or personal property.
