## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

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BILL NO. HB 203

### Analysis

HB203 would change AS 21.54.020(a) by adding the requirement that out-of-network health insurance provider payments must be made out to both the provider and the covered person as joint payees, requiring both to endorse the check.

HB203 would also require health care insurers to reimburse a person covered by their policy for payments they have made if the covered person can provide convincing evidence they paid the provider for the covered services.

It is not anticipated that this legislation would have a fiscal impact on the Division of Insurance.
