A Brief Comparison

Committee Substitute for Sponsor Substitute for Senate Bill 100 Changes Made to SS for SB 100

(New Language is bold and underlined)

- Page 3, Line 28 An individual learning plan must be developed with the assistance **and approval** of the certified teacher assigned to the student by the district.
- Page 4, Line 8 An individual learning plan must **provide for monitoring of each student's work and progress by the certificated teacher assigned to the student.**
- Page 4, Line 19 A parent or guardian may purchase **nonsectarian** services and
Page 4, Line 20 materials from a **public**, private, or religious organization with a student allotment Provided under (a) of this section if
- Page 4, Line 24 (1) the services and materials are required for the course of student in the individual learning plan developed for the student under AS 14.03.300;
- (2) textbooks, services, and other curriculum materials and the course of study;**
- (A) are approved by the school district**
- (B) are appropriate for the student;**
- (C) are aligned to state standards; and**
- (D) comply with AS 14.03.090 and AS 14.18.060;**
- and**

(3) otherwise support a public purpose.

... an annual student allotment shall

(1) return the unexpected balance of a student allotment to the budget of the department or district for a student who is no longer enrolled in the correspondence program for which the allotment was provided;

(2) maintain a record of expenditures and allotments;
and

(3) implement a routine monitoring of audits and expenditures.

(e) A student allotment provided under (a) of this section may not be used to pay for services provided to a student by a family member. In this section, "family member" means the student's spouse, guardian, parent, stepparent, sibling, stepsibling grandparent, stepgrandparent, child, uncle, or aunt.
