# **Analysis**

This legislation clarifies the current statue, AS 14.33.200 (Harassment, intimidation, and bullying policy) by including "electronic communication" in the definition of "harassment, intimation or bullying." This addresses the issue of "cyber bullying" and requires such incidents to be reported to an appropriate school official. Additionally, this legislation amends AS 14.33.250 (Definitions) to include electronic or oral communication.	
The existing statute includes written, oral or physical act as the definition of harassment, intimidation or bullying. All districts have safe guards in place, as outlined in the district education technologies plan, that address "cyber bullying" issues and currently report incidents of "harassment, intimation or bullying" to the department.
