FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to employer drug testing; requiring the Alaska Workers'
- 2 Compensation Board to adopt regulations relating to the prescription of controlled
- 3 substances to employees; and limiting the prescription of controlled substances to
- 4 employees."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 23.10.620 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 7 (g) In addition to the tests required under (c) and (d) of this section, an
- 8 employer may require an employee to undergo drug testing if the employee has been
- 9 prescribed a controlled substance listed in schedule IA under AS 11.71.140 for more
- than 90 consecutive days by a physician under AS 23.30.095.
- * Sec. 2. AS 23.30.005 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 12 (n) The board shall adopt regulations relating to the prescription of controlled
- substances to implement AS 23.30.095(p).
- * Sec. 3. AS 23.30.095 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

1	(p) A physician may not prescribe to an employee under this chapter more
2	than a 30-day supply of a controlled substance listed in schedule IA under
3	AS 11.71.140 or a controlled opium substance listed in schedule IIIA under
4	AS 11.71.160 or schedule VA under AS 11.71.180.
